This document explains the steps that students must take to pay their bill or confirm their attendance (if financial aid

electronic payment from you 529 plan, the College is not setup to accept them electronically and a check will be mailed out. Please allow sufficient time for the payment to reach the college by the deadlines noted above.

Financial Aid, Zero Balance Bills and Scholarships

If financial aid results in a zero balance on the summer session bill, students must confirm their attendance by May 7, 2024. To do this, students must go to sunysuffolk.edu/login and access their Student Dashboard, select Pay Bill or Confirm Attendance and follow the instructions. There is no cost associated with confirming attendance.

Students who have been awarded financial aid or scholarships can have those amounts credited to their bill. Student bills reflect anticipated financial aid as of the date of the bill. If a student receives notice that his/her financial aid has been approved and it does not appear on his/her bill, the student should contact the campus Financial Aid Office immediately.

If a student was notified of a scholarship and it does not appear on his/her bill, the student should contact the office that sent the scholarship award notice. If financial aid or scholarships change after payment has been made or after confirming attendance, bills will be sent for any resulting balances or a refund will be issued through
