

**POLICY FOR ENROLLING STUDENTS AT SUFFOLK COUNTY COMMUNITY
COLLEGE WHOSE HIGH SCHOOL CLASS HAS NOT YET GRADUATED**

STUDENTS SEEKING MATRICULATION

A student whose high school class has not yet graduated, and who applies for admission to a degree program at Suffolk County Community College, may be admitted under the following conditions:

1. the student must have no more than one year of high school studies remaining;
2. the high school principal must provide the College with a written request for early admission;
3. the student's high school guidance counselor must recommend the student for admission;
4. the student must be beyond the age of compulsory attendance in New York State (i.e., the end of the high school year in which the student turned 16); and
