Synchronous online classes and in-person classes are treated the same with respect to teaching pedagogy.

Faculty can blur their background, or use a virtual background, but their camera must be on for the duration of the class session.

Synchronous online classes and in-person classes are also treated the same with respect to student attendance and class participation. In the absence of extenuating circumstances, students are required to have their cameras on for the duration of the class.

Understanding that not all students may have the same access to Wi-Fi, that some students may not have the capability to blur their backgrounds due to technology limitations, and/or may be attending classes virtually from locations other than their homes, we ask for flexibility. If a student is using a public space for Wi-Fi access while attending an online class, using their microphone may not be permissible and outside noise may interfere with the class.
