Commitment of the College

- a. The College will partner with the ULLI to enroll students in the ECP, Continuing Education, or ~~another appropriate program along multiple tracks. Accordingly, depending on the student's~~

age, high school grades, placement test scores, and/or aspirations, students shall be eligible for admissions to the College's credit-bearing classes as regular non-matriculated students, or to non-credit-bearing classes as career-track non-matriculated students.

- b. Placement testing will be conducted by the College at one of its campuses at an agreed mutual time.
- c. Program or class assignments are based on the sole professional assessment of College employees and are not subject to review.
- d. Programs or classes will be offered at the campus of participant assignment. Students may be



- a. The initial term of this Agreement shall be from June 1, 2016 to May 31, 2017. Thereafter, the Agreement shall automatically renew from year to year, unless it is cancelled, in writing, by either party no fewer than sixty (60) days prior to the renewal date.
- b. Any announcement or other public statement made by any party concerning this Agreement or the relationship between the parties shall be subject to the review and approval of the Urban League of America.
